Additional Needs & Adjustments

Please tell us about any additional needs or adjustments that could help your child participate safely and positively. We will consider reasonable adjustments in discussion with the family while taking account of the activity, environment, staffing and safety of everyone involved.

Positive Behaviour

Gymnasts are expected to listen to staff, respect others and use equipment safely. Coaches use clear, age-appropriate expectations and positive behaviour management.

Bullying

Bullying, harassment or deliberate intimidation is not accepted. Concerns will be taken seriously and addressed fairly. Parents/carers are encouraged to tell us promptly if their child is worried about another participant's behaviour.

Working Together

Where behaviour becomes repeatedly unsafe or seriously affects others, the club will work with the parent/carer on appropriate next steps. In serious situations, participation may need to be paused or ended to protect safety and welfare.
